

- A developmental disorder.
- Affects a person's social communication and interaction.
- A person with autism may have restricted and repetitive behavior, interests and activities.
- A life long journey.
- Something that affects the whole family.

Most children with autism can be diagnosed between 18 and 24 months of age.

FIRST SIGNS OF AUTISM:

- No babbling by 12 months
- No pointing or gesturing by 12 months
- No single words by 16 months
- Loss of previously acquired skills, especially language
- Child does not respond to his/her name

NUMBERS IN AUTISM

- 1 in 45 children in NJ have autism
- 1 in 68 children have autism nationwide
- · Boys are four times more likely to have autism than girls

- Many families with autism are living very isolated lives. Communities

- When children turn 21 and leave school, there are not enough programs to meet their adult needs.
- There is no known cause or cure for autism. Fortunately family support and treatment are a phone call away.
