For each presenter (unless special arrangements have been made, each workshop is limited to 2 presenters unless it is a panel format):

- Full contact information (mailing address, phone, email)
- Bio to be posted on website
- Resume/CV
- Any relevant financial/nonfinancial disclosures
- If a first-time presenter with Autism New Jersey, a letter of recommendation on:
 - Knowledge of the content to be discussed
 - Presenting skills

For the workshop:

- Title
- 1 75-minute part or 2 parts?
- Relevant to learners requiring significant or minimal supports (or both)?
- Bibliography of 3-4 references since 2016 (in APA format)
- Abstract
 - At least 500 words, including empirical evidence for any treatments to be discussed. Provide as much detail as you think beneficial to the review committee.
- Time-ordered agenda in no greater than 15-minute increments
 - Formatted "15 minutes: Review of scientific literature on activity schedules 10 minutes: Practical uses of activity schedules (includes video)"
 - Do not spend time on simple background information on autism, ABA, etc. for this audience.
- 3 specific, observable, and measurable learning objectives
 - Formatted "Participants will..."
- One-paragraph description for the agenda
 - Specific content and activity descriptions will help participants know what to expect.
